

Workshop on Photo Journalism (10-12th, March, 2014)

A three days workshop on Photo Journalism was organised for the students of BJMC on March 10, 2014. The objective of the workshop was to make them learn –

- ✓ The difference between General Photography and Photo Journalism.
- ✓ Write through light.
- ✓ News sense through Camera.
- ✓ Necessary Skills for News Photography.
- ✓ Field Exposure with Camera.

The three day workshop was conducted by eminent Photo Journalist and **Former Chief Photographer of THE INDIAN EXPRESS, Raaj Dayal**. Total 98 students registered themselves for the workshop.

Day 1 (10th March 2014)

Mr. Dayal introduced students with the world of PHOTO JOURNALISM by sharing his exclusive experience as PHOTO JOURNALIST.

Day 2 (11th March 2014)

Second Day was planned for field exposure and students were called at Central Park, Connaught Place. After taking class for around one and half hour, students were dispersed to click shots having news and feature angle. Three hours were given them to take photographs. Students went to all the potential places for news photography such as -Hanumaan Mandir, Janpath, Bangla Sahib Gurudwara, Inner Circle Corridors of Connaught Place, Baba Khadak Singh Marg etc. They were suppose to click photographs in Three categories –

- ✚ **Stand Alone Photograph**
- ✚ **Portrait Photograph**
- ✚ **Photo Feature/ Photo Story**

Day 3 (12th March 2014)

Third and concluding day was the day of evaluation of the photographs clicked by the students and giving them suggestions, selection of best photographs in all three categories. In each category there were two prizes - winner and Runner up. Following were the result of competition-
