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Ensuring High Attendance in Classes:


In order to improve attendance in classes the Management has decided to adopt a Carrot & Stick Policy i.e. rewards for good performers and punishments for non-performers. All those students whose attendance is above 90% will get reward and those whose attendance is less than 75% i.e. those who are not eligible to appear in the University Examinations as per the University rules will get punishment as described below:-

Rewards:- For every extra completed 1% attendance above 90% an incentive of Rs. 1,000/-, which implies that a student having 91% attendance will get reward of Rs. 1,000/-, one whose attendance is between 95-96% will get Rs. 5,000/- and all those having 100% attendance will get reward of Rs. 10,000/- each.

Punishments:- Students who are short of attendance i.e. whose attendance is less than 75% are not eligible to appear in the University Examinations and shall be detained unless they complete their attendance by attending extra classes which the institute will organize for them at their cost after the suspension of teaching i.e. during the preparatory holidays. Such students will have to pay Rs. 1,000/- for each percent by which their attendance is short. This implies that the student with 74% attendance will pay a sum of Rs. 1,000/-; while one with 70% will pay Rs.5,000/-, and another with 50% shall pay Rs. 25,000/- . Under no circumstances a student whose attendance is below 50% shall be allowed to appear in the University Examinations.

The rewards to the students with higher attendance shall be given out of the penalties so collected. Any saving in the account shall be used for the welfare of students and staff in different forms which may include educational tours/adventures activities/ participation in Conferences at National or International level and shall not be transferred to the Management fund. Any deficiency in the amount shall be met with by the Management from its own resources.

The policy is being implemented with immediate effect i.e. from session 2019-20 and is subject to review, if required, in subsequent years.
